The area consists of Glendale, Belford, Rotham Islandshire, District Councils and Burgh of Berwick-upon-Tweed, with offices at Berwick. A steering committee had been formed with two representatives from each Council, this Committee is to draw up working arrangements for changeovers, first meeting to be held in June. Glendale will have six Councillors on new Council.

The present Glendale area West of River Till, north of river Bowmont, College Valley and Kettlewell, will have one representative on Council. This was all that was reported to date.

It was proposed, seconded and carried unanimously that Mr R.A.H. Chatters be selected to represent Rotham Parish Council, his name to be put forward as their nominee.

Scottish Omnibuses had intimated the possible withdrawal of the Helso/Cornhill service. This is a Bedwicks service with interchange to limited Bus at Cornhill.

Mr Menneard outlined the position of subsidies, the County Council subsidy was 40%, the overall

Government subsidy was 75%.
 He also explained that unless fares taken by the operators on any particular service covered a "laid down" percentage of "cost of running" the Ministry would withdraw subsidies.

Mr Henderson gave figures of passengers travelling, these had been taken at random and showed that there is little demand for this service especially on a Wednesday.

After much discussion it was agreed that until the Ministry made an objection the service be run as at present. If the Ministry raised the matter, it should be requested to subsidise the running of the service on a Saturday, but discontinue the Wednesday service.

Peel Hospital Bus:

The direct service from Kelso to Peel Hospital on a Sunday, does not await the arrival of the Newcastle/Kelso service. The bus to the Hospital leaves five minutes before the limited bus reaches Kelso. Visitors to the Hospital from this area had to

depend on private transport to reach
 theso on time.

Mr Henderson agreed to take-up this
 matter with the Bus Company.
